Initial Study Report Meeting

Black Canyon Hydro, LLC (BCH) filed its Initial Study Report for the Black Canyon Hydroelectric Project (FERC No. P-14110) on February 6, 2014. The Initial Study Report Meeting is being held on February 24th and 25th, 2014. Typically the meeting is scheduled 15-days after the filing of the Initial Study Report. However, the meeting has been scheduled 18-days after filing in an effort to accommodate stakeholders. Additionally, since the meeting is being moved slightly back, it will not shorten the time period available for stakeholders to review reports prior to the meeting.

An approximate meeting agenda is being provided, however, BCH wants to emphasize that it is approximate and there will almost inevitably be some changes made based on stakeholder input or particular study plans requiring more or less time. BCH has tried to group study plans that are closely related or focus on the same resource type.

Generally, BCH will begin the discussion of each study report with a brief 5-10 minute summary of results before inviting questions and comments.
