Re: Filing of Proposed Study Plans for Integrated Licensing Process

Dear Secretary Bose,

Black Canyon Hydro, LLC (BCH) is submitting six documents in response to requests made by FERC staff and other participants following the filing of Proposed Study Plans and the associated Proposed Study Plan Meeting on October 4 and 5, 2012.

Two additional proposed study plans are being submitted at the recommendation of FERC staff to address both “Geology and Soils” and “Erosion Control.” Additionally, a Supplement to the Pre-Application Document (PAD) provides an updated Project description and presents alternative intake structures, all of which have been developed in response to stakeholder comment. A Communication and Information Protocol has also been drafted, along with a Resource Work Group Protocol which describes the status of three possible resource work groups identified at the Proposed Study Plan Meeting. Finally, a preliminary fisheries study report titled “Abundance, distribution, and habitat use by trout and other fishes in the North Fork Snoqualmie River, WA,” which describes the findings of field surveys conducted in August 2012, is being submitted for stakeholder review.
